HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING FLOAT GUIDLINES

(Your winning homecoming float should remain the same as it did for your homecoming.)

You will be escorted off the parade route if you violate any of our rules and regulations.

YOU CANNOT HAND OR THROW ANYTHING OUT DURING THE PARADE

- 1. <u>Your school's marching band MUST participate to enter your school's winning</u> homecoming class float in the Thanksgiving Day Parade.
- 2. All floats <u>MUST</u> include your school mascot.
- 3. We will award a trophy and commemorative picture for the **<u>BEST</u>** homecoming float.
- 4. You <u>MUST</u> follow all the Parade <u>FLOAT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS</u> (FLOAT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS are located on page 13 of the packet).
- 5. <u>NO semi-trucks or semi-trailers</u> will be permitted in the parade.
- 6. You <u>MUST</u> provide your tow vehicle insurance card and coverage to Joe Daubach when submitting the application.
- 7. You <u>MUST</u> pass the EPFD safety check the day before. Any float that does not pass the safety check <u>WILL NOT</u> be able to participate parade day.
- 8. <u>NO ONE</u> will be permitted to ride in the back of the tow vehicle due to safety reasons.
- 9. <u>NO</u> live microphones and <u>NO</u> inappropriate music lyrics will be allowed; however Rock 'n' Roll Music is a <u>MUST</u> to follow the parade theme.
- 10. The tow vehicle <u>MAY</u> have decorations, objects etc. relating to the theme on it but they <u>MUST NOT</u> obstruct the view of the driver (windows must remain clear).
- 11. The tow vehicle **MUST** be clean and presentable.
- **12.** We **<u>REQUIRE</u>** for you to have a 3' x 3' sign on each side of the tow vehicle stating.

- 13. All floats <u>MUST</u> be parked in your designated location the night before the parade (we hire EPPD to watch the floats overnight but are not responsible for your float). Joe Daubach will coordinate this with each homecoming float.
- 14. You are <u>ALLOWED</u> to have a walking banner (3' x 9') in front of your float.
- 15. You are <u>ALLOWED</u> to have up to 50 people walking with the class float (themed costumes are encouraged). It is you or your school's responsibility to coordinate their transportation to and from the parade. We do provide a bus drop off location in the staging area and bus parking in the disbanding area at the end of the parade route for bands and JROTC and we can do the same for this. THIS IS ONLY FOR BUSES AND NOT FOR INDIVIDUAL VEHICLES.
